Clinton County is developing a Brownfield Pre-Planning and Analysis study intended to identify concentrations of vacant, abandoned, underused, and potential brownfield properties. As part of this effort, the County and its consultant team, including Barton & Loguidice and 4ward Planning, invite you to attend a public workshop at the Clinton County Government Center's 1st floor meeting room on Tuesday, September 22, 2026 from 6:30 -8:00 p.m.

The workshop will introduce the project and Brownfield Opportunity Area (BOA) program, summarize the completed countywide inventory, and focus on 18 potential redevelopment sites visited during the project's study area tour in June 2026.

Residents, property owners, business owners, municipal officials, community organizations, and other interested members of the public are encouraged to attend and share local knowledge and meet with the project team.

Important Planning Note: Properties included in the inventory have been identified solely for preliminary planning and analysis. Inclusion does not constitute a determination that contamination is present; that a property is a brownfield; that an owner or operator is responsible for contamination; or that a property is eligible for BOA designation, the Brownfield Cleanup Program, or another funding or regulatory program.
