County of Clinton IDA Mission Statement:

County of Clinton IDA Operations Statement:

1. Have the board members acknowledged that they have read and understood the mission of the public authority?

Yes, the CCIDA has reviewed the original Mission Statement, as well as the current annual update. CCIDA's Mission Statement was initially approved by the Agency in 2012 and was reaffirmed in 2015, 2016 and 2017.

2. Who has the power to appoint the management of the public authority?

CCIDA selects and appoints the Executive Director who performs on behalf of the Agency Board. The Executive Director only works on IDA projects. The IDA Board also reviews and adopts, annually, all budgets, fiscal and administrative reports.

3. If the Board appoints management, do you have a policy you follow when appointing the management of the public authority?

The CCIDA Board appoints management and is responsible for oversight of management's work. The Agency has entered into an annual Administrative Services Agreement with Clinton County for the services of the County's Economic Development Director, who serves as CCIDA's Executive Director. CCIDA has also entered into an Administrative Services Agreement for administrative services provided by the staff of The Development Corporation, a professional economic development organization, operating in Clinton County.

4. Briefly describe the role of the Board and the role of management in the implementation of the mission.

The CCIDA Board provides oversight of all management operations and determines whether projects seeking assistance meet the Agency's mission and objectives. Management works with the community and businesses to identify opportunities to facilitate CCIDA's mission and goals.

5. Has the Board acknowledged that they have read and understood the responses to each of these questions?
