WHEREAS, Clinton Grant Facilitation Corporation (the "Corporation") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of 402 and Section 1411 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law of the State of New York to promote community and economic development and the creation of jobs for the citizens of Clinton County, New York (the "County") by, among other things, facilitating the economic development of the County and the adjoining counties of Essex and Franklin (collectively, the "Grant Area") through the receipt and administration of gifts, grants, loans, or contributions relating to any portion of the Grant Area from, and enter into contracts or other transactions with, the United States and the State of New York or any Corporation of either of them, any municipality, any public or private corporation or any other legal entity; and

Dear Mr. Wilber:

Please accept this Letter of Notification to Apply for Northern Border Regional Commission State Economic & Infrastructure Investment and Development Program Funds on behalf of the Clinton Grant Facilitation Corporation, a subsidiary of the County of Clinton Industrial Development Agency. Funds obtained through this award will develop infrastructure at the site of South Junction Enterprise's Bulk Transfer Facility located at 382 South Junction Road in Plattsburgh, New York to expand rail capacity in order to meet increased demand for rail shipments in Clinton County and the surrounding region (the "South Junction Project"). It should be noted that this site is situated adjacent to Plattsburgh International Airport and the former Plattsburgh Air Force Base, which is now a thriving industrial park. Both the state and federal governments have invested in improvements and companies in this area. All of these funds have leveraged millions of dollars in private investment and created thousands of jobs.

The South Junction Project consists of constructing a new railroad track 2,700 feet in length that will connect to existing trackage and one storage silo, which will result in doubling the facility's capacity. These investments will allow local rail users to enjoy the environmental and economic benefits of using rail to bring in their bulk commodities for local distribution. This author is the authorized applicant and can accept this funding on behalf of the Clinton Grant Facilitation Corporation; as a subsidiary of the County of Clinton Industrial Development Agency, our DUNS number is 963259556. This author will serve as the project primary contact if funds are awarded from this application. The project is located in Clinton County, a Designated Distressed County in the Local Development District of the Lake Champlain-Lake George Region, represented by Congresswoman Elise M. Stefanik in the 21st Congressional District of New York State. The Clinton Grant Facilitation Corporation was not required to submit a "Single Audit" in the past twelve months.

Clinton County is requesting \$750,000 from the Northern Border Regional Commission for the South Junction Project. The total cost for this project is \$1.5 million. South Junction Enterprises is prepared to invest \$750,000 of private funds.
